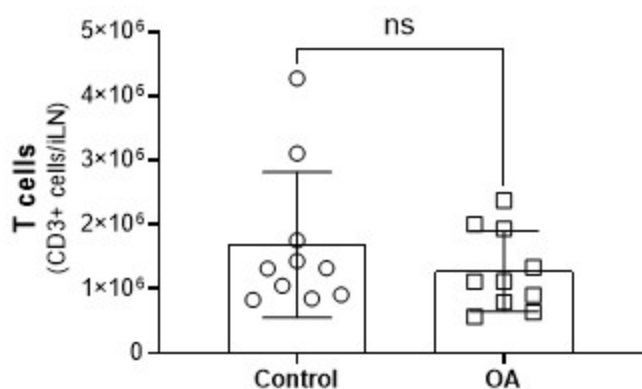
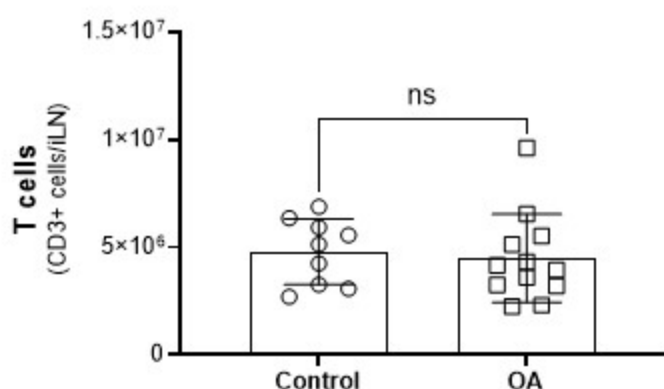

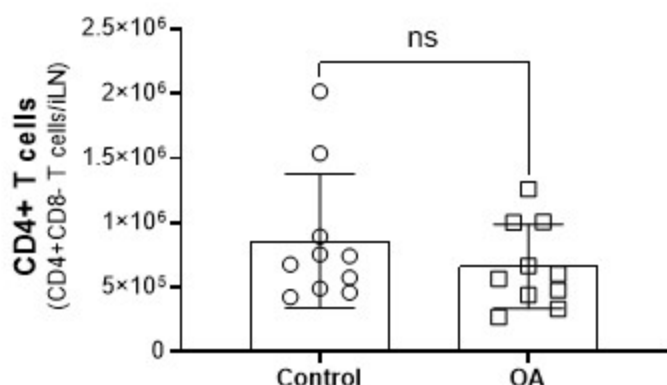

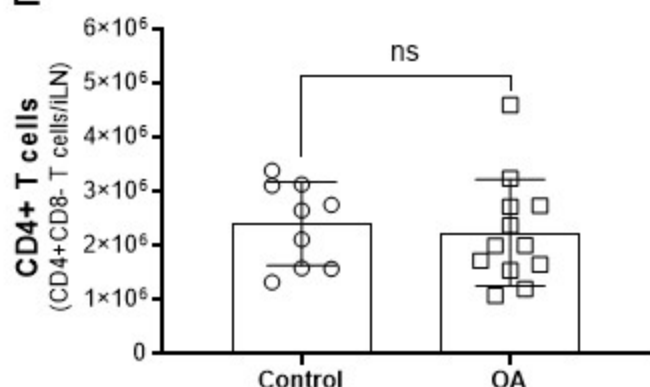

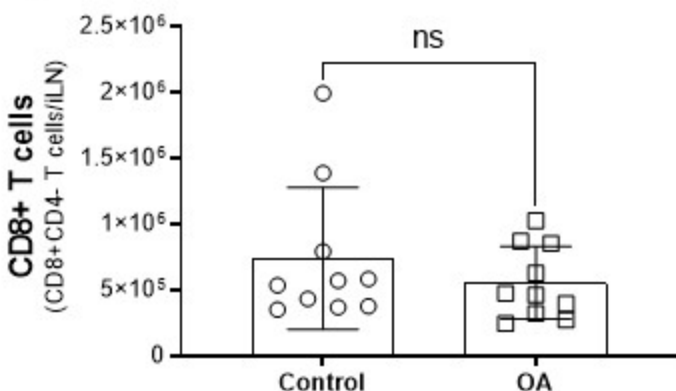

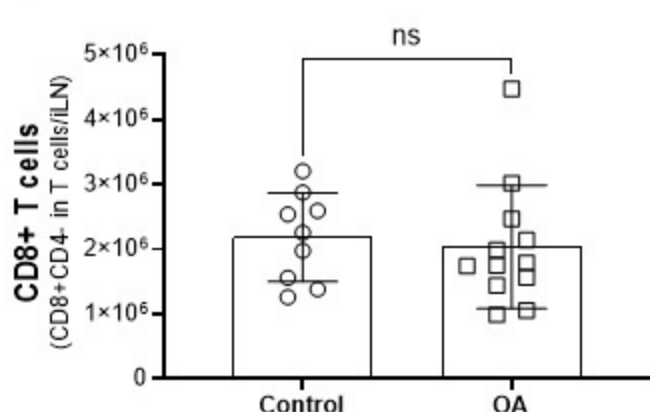

Supplementary figure 7 – The numbers of CD4+ T cells and CD8+ T cells in inguinal lymph nodes are not affected in OA mice at an early stage of the disease. Mice subjected to DMM (OA group) or control surgery (Control group) were sacrificed after 2 and 8 weeks, and the inguinal lymph nodes were collected for FACS analysis. The graphs show the plotted data from the FACS analysis of total T cells, CD4+ T cells and CD8+ T cells at 2 weeks (A-C) and 8 weeks after surgery (D-F).
